## **Please don't park in the fire lane!**

This purpose of the fire lanes is to prevent parking and standing in front of or adjacent to fire hydrants and to provide clear access to building and fire protection equipment for fire rescue apparatus. Parking or otherwise obstructing such areas is prohibited by the Fire Marshall's Office. First responders cannot put out the fire, rescue the patient, or otherwise conduct emergency operations unless they can get to the emergency.
