1. Superintendent's Advisory Representative

- Ms. Jenna Beth Mau was selected as Sinclair's representative for the Superintendent's Advisory Council.

2. Welcome and Introductions

3. Budget Update

- While class sizes remain small, enrollment and budget considerations continue to be monitored closely.

- Partner with local businesses and community organizations (such as Baskin-Robbins) to support fundraising and community engagement.
