

**Kindergarten
At Home Activities

Math Fun:

- Count out loud to 100
- Count by 10's
- Count objects around the house (beans, cups, toys, light switches, doors, windows)
- Write numbers on paper
- Use a stick to write numbers in dirt outside
- Use water to write numbers on the sidewalk outside and watch them disappear
- Keep track of the weather- record if it's sunny, windy, rainy, or cloudy.
- Use different objects (buttons, rocks, leaves, etc.) make AB, AAB, ABC, and ABB patterns.
- Collect, sort and count loose change from around your house.

Deck of Cards:

- The card game "war"- First, take out the face cards. Then, split the deck, making a "fair share" between two players. After that, each **player** turns up a card at the same time and the **player** with the higher card takes both cards and puts them, face down, on the bottom of his stack. If the cards are the same rank, it is **War**. Each **player** turns up one card face down and one card face up. The **player** with the higher cards takes both piles (six cards).
- Go Fish
- What number comes before and after?
- Put cards in order
- Build a tower with the cards

Read It:

- Listen to a story on YouTube or Storyline <https://www.storylineonline.net/> and talk about it
- Read a book to a stuffed animal.
- Read a book under the covers with a flashlight.
- Search for sight words in books
- Draw and tell your own story using at least 2 characters with a beginning, middle, end

Word Fun:

- Rainbow write sight words using crayons or markers
- Use Legos to build your sight words.
- Build your sight words with play doh.
- Practice writing your first and last name
- Alphabet scavenger hunt (inside or outside)
- Draw and tell your own story using at least 2 characters with a beginning, middle, end
- Watch your favorite TV show and draw and write about it. What was your favorite part? Who are the characters? What is the setting?

Kindergarten At Home Activities 2020

- Practice rhyming. Ask a parent to say a word for you and see how many real and silly words you can rhyme with it.
- Use a stick to practice writing sight words in the dirt.
- Use half of an apple to carve a face. Give your face a name and write about them. Add chocolate chips or raisins to make eyes and then enjoy as a snack!



Move It:

- Nature Walk – write down what you find
- Practice jump roping
- Make an obstacle course and see how long it takes you to complete it
- Do GoNoodle for 15 minutes. www.gonoodle.com
- Make up a new dance to a favorite song. Video tape it.

Create It:

- Get a mirror and look at your reflection to draw a self-portrait.
- Make a sock puppet and put on a play.
- Sit outside and watch the clouds. Can you see any pictures in the clouds? Draw pictures of what you see.
- Use recycled materials like boxes, bottles, rubber bands to make an instrument. Play a concert for your family.
- Build a fort from sheets.
- Plant a seed and watch it grow.
